



Appendix: General Conditions for the Reproduction of Matisse's Artworks by the Press During the Exhibition

1. Conditions for the Press of countries where Henri Matisse IS in the public domain (e.g. China)

- Use only images provided by the Musée Matisse to UCCA Center for Contemporary Art.
- The artwork must not be cropped.
- Overprinting (with text, symbols or logos) of the artwork is not permitted.

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2. Conditions for the Press of countries where Henri Matisse IS NOT in the public domain (e.g. European Union, U.S.)

General conditions of reproduction of the work:

- Use only images provided by the Musée Matisse to UCCA Center for Contemporary Art.
- The artwork must not be cropped.
- Overprinting (with text, symbols or logos) of the artwork is not permitted.
- The reproductions must be accompanied by the copyright notice:

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The exemption of copyright fees applies only in the following cases:

- Only two reproductions of artworks from the press kit, of a maximum format of a quarter page, are exempted from copyright fees.
- Photographs of general views of the exhibition rooms, as well as the official poster, are also exempt from copyright fees.

3. Other rules:

- Any additional reproduction, or any reproduction exceeding a quarter page, will result in the application of the corresponding copyright fees.
- If there are more than two reproductions (photographs of general views are not included), a High Definition layout must be submitted for approval by e-mail to gwenaellefossard.lhm@orange.fr
